The Sing Canada Harmony Scholarship Fund was created to assist Canadians by providing financial assistance for educational and training opportunities in vocal music performance, vocal music leadership, vocal music administration and vocal music composition, arrangement, adjudication and staging. The intent is to provide funding for learning opportunities for Canadian men and women, **particularly children and youth** to gain expertise and experience in the field of a cappella vocal music harmony singing in quartets and choruses.

Sing Canada Harmony believes that vocal music, particularly four-part a cappella harmony in the Barbershop style, plays a vital role in the development of healthy, creative and responsible members of society.

This belief results in a commitment toward ensuring equal access to vocal music arts for people of all ages, particularly the children and youth of Canada, and the men and women who help enrich others' lives through singing and instruction in singing.

Funds are raised by donations and the efforts of Barbershop Harmony singers and others who value the importance of vocal music in Canadian schools and communities. Application is open to legal residents of Canada only.

Principal learning opportunities that are supported typically by Sing Canada Harmony scholarships for Canadians are:

- Those sponsored by the Barbershop Harmony Society (BHS), Harmony, Incorporated (HI) or Sweet Adelines International (SAI) such as:
 - Harmony Explosion Experiences or Camps for children, youth and music educators;
 - Harmony University, Harmony Colleges and Directors College;
 - Leadership Academies for Chapter Officers (formerly COTS), Harmony Intensive Training School (HITS), Harmony Education Days, Harmony Education Programs (HEP) and Chorus Director Development Training;
- University and College degree and diploma programs or courses in vocal music;
- Other approved programs, seminars, courses and training in vocal music.
